Our main stop will be Cairnbaan Hotel which is located at Lock #5 of the canal. Opened in 1801, the canal is still active today as it links Ardrishaig on Loch Fyne with Crinan on the Atlantic coast. During this stop we should see boating activity

in the lock, and there will be time for a leisurely stroll along the canal.

Later, we continue north along the eastern shores of Loch Fyne to Inveraray, and our destination, the **Loch Fyne Hotel**.

Activity Driver rest day. We are free to explore Inveraray, traditional county town of Argyll, and ancestral home of the **Duke of Argyll**, who founded the town in 1745,

alongside his new dwelling, Inveraray Castle. www.inveraray-argyll.com

Much of the town, including the church, was designed and built by the Edinburgh-born architect Robert Mylne between 1772 and 1800.

You will find the Woolen Shop, and two Whisky Shops, among the many aspects of Inveraray. One of the popular attractions is the **Old Inveraray Jail**, available to us for a self-guided tour. www.inverarayjail.co.uk

A good physical activity would be to hike up to **Dùn na Cuaiche** for the view over the town, and down Loch Fyne.

Day 7 Thursday, 10th June, 2021

Morning visit to **Inveraray Castle.** We will have a guided tour of the castle, the home of the **Duke of Argyll**, who is also the Chief of the Clan Campbell. An Inveraray Castle has been standing on the shores of Loch Fyne since the 1400s, although the impressive castle we know today was inspired by a sketch by Vanbrugh, the architect of Blenheim Palace and Castle Howard in the 1700s. www.inveraray-castle.com

Afternoon visit to **Auchindrain Township**. "Long ago, Scotland had thousands of "townships", small farming communities where groups of families worked together. Then, two hundred and fifty years ago, the world began to change. The townships were replaced by modern farms, crofting and large estates".

The visit will include an introductory welcome, refreshments, and self guided time around the old houses, barns, and impliments.
