Day 1 Wednesday 14th April, 2027

After lunch we will embark on the black taxi tour. This is a Belfast political mural tour where passengers get to explore and experience the famous West Belfast murals. We will hear first-hand the raw side of historic Belfast City, and its colourful history, with local guides who have lived through the troubles and have many stories to tell.

Belfast Castle. Belfast Castle sits at the foot of Cave Hill and is one of the most iconic locations from which to view the stunning skyline of Belfast.
