Day 1 Saturday, 2nd Oct, 2021

Activity As tour members arrive independently at Glasgow Airport, cross the road to the

Holiday Inn, and check in under **MINCH MUSIC TOUR**. (Note: The Holiday Inn, and NOT the Holiday Inn Express)

Gather in the bar for a Welcome Drink at 6.00pm, prior to Dinner at 7.00pm.

Day 2 Sunday, 3rd Oct, 2021

Activity Drive north by way of the A-9 road passing Stirling, Perth, Pitlochry en route.

Stop at Blair Castle, by Blair Atholl, for a self-guided tour of the castle, garden

and deer park. This is the ancestral home of the Clan Murray.

Activity At 8.30am... We depart Inverness, northbound on the A9 through the counties of

Sutherland and Caithness to the ferry terminal at Gills Bay.

Ferry departs at 1.30pm for the 1 hour crossing to St Margaret's Hope, on South

Ronaldsay, then we drive to the Orkney Hotel in Kirkwall.

Today we stop at the <u>Standing Stones of Stenness</u>, and the <u>Ring of Brodgar</u> in the morning. After lunch, we drive by the <u>Brough of Birsay</u>, followed by a visit to the popular <u>Corrigall Farm Museum</u>. The site has a working barn, grain kiln,

horse-drawn machinery and livestock.

Day 5 Wednesday, 6th Oct, 2021

Activity Depart 9.30am with Marita Luck to visit the <u>Italian Chapel</u> and drive by <u>Scapa</u>

Flow (Aspects from WW11 relating to the Italian Prisoners of War, the Churchill

Barriers, and the sinking of HMS Royal Oak on October 14, 1939).

Then on to the second largest town of **Stromness** for a lunch stop. In the

afternoon we take in <u>Skara Brae</u>, and <u>Skaill House</u>. Skara Brae is a stone-built Neolithic settlement, located on the Bay of Skaill on the west coast of Mainland, the largest island in the Orkney archipelago of Scotland. Consisting of eight clustered houses, it was occupied from roughly 3180 BC to about 2500 BC.

Europe's most complete Neolithic village. (Provided Lunch at Ferry Inn, Stromness)

Activity In the morning, we will take a **Walking Tour of Kirkwall** with Marita. This will

story.

Our second stop will be the field at Balnuaran to visit the Bronze Age circular chamber tombs known as the <u>Clava Cairns</u>. before returning to our hotel.

Nevis valley. Then, by way of **Glencoe** and **Loch Lomond**, we arrive late
